

# Off Licence

Section 17 to 20, 64 and 135, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

007/OFF/9059/2020

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Burgerburger Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell or deliver alcohol on or from the premises situated at **1 Queen Street Auckland Central Auckland**, and known as **Burger Burger**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

## CONDITIONS

The conditions of the licence are as follows:

- a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day.
- b) **Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:**

**MONDAY to SUNDAY**

**11.00am to 11.00pm**

- c) Drinking water is to be freely available to customers immediately adjacent to any alcohol that is being supplied free as a sample on the premises.
- d) The following designations apply:
  - i. Before 10.00pm, the area in front of the bar is designated as supervised, the remainder of the premises shall be undesignated.
  - ii. After 10.00pm, the whole of the premises is designated as supervised, except for the public access walkway which shall be undesignated.
- e) The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
  - i. Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
  - ii. Ensure that appropriate signs are prominently displayed detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons, at each entry and adjacent to every point of sale.

## DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licenses, this licence continues in force—

- (a) either—
  - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
  - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

**This licence expires at the close of the 8<sup>th</sup> day of April 2021 unless renewed.**
